Corrugated Cardboard	Corrugated cardboard, Paper board (cereal, Tissue, Chip boxes), Milk/Juice cartons	Contaminated paperboard, Egg cartons, Styrofoam.	Remove all packaging and Styrofoam. Flatten and bundle.
Paper	Newspaper, office paper, Notebook, Catalog, Magazine, Manila folders, Envelopes, Phone books	Blue print, Carbon paper, Food packaging, Paper plates & cups, Metal bindings	Remove metal bindings. Put in stacked bundles or put in brown paper bags.
Plastic Food & Beverage Containers #1-6	Milk jugs, pop bottles, Beverage containers, Cool whip & butter tubs, Shampoo bottles, Laundry soap jugs	Plastic bags, Plastic wrap, Toys, Utensils, Plant containers, Lawn chairs, Oil jugs, Dishes	Rinse container of food or other residue. Caps/lids may remain on container.
Glass Food & Beverage Containers	Beverage & food containers- clear, green, blue and brown glass	Window & door glass, Light bulbs, Ceramics, Pyrex, Drinking glasses	Rinse thoroughly and remove lids
