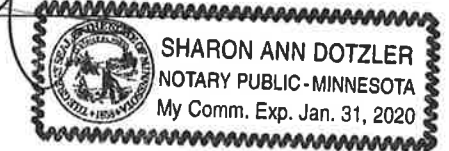

Motion carried, Westerlund/ Marcotte, to approve the May 10, 2016 amended agenda. Consent Agenda Item 21, Adopt Resolution - 2016 Federal Supplemental Boating Safety Patrol Grant Agreement was added, and Agenda Items 6B1, Approve 2016 Community Corrections Budget, and 6B2, Approve Community Corrections Plan were removed.
