

#### Career Edventure

- Collaboration with area schools, individual student consultations, group & classroom activities, workshops, business interaction opportunities
- Pre-ETS (Employment & Transition Services)
  - Collaboration with State Vocational Rehabilitation to specifically serve high school students with disabilities
  - Job exploration, counseling, workplace readiness training, instruction in selfadvocacy, and work experiences

NEMOJT has eight percent of youth participants statewide, but 26 percent of all youth with a WEX activity (counted by the person, not the number of activities/experiences).
