| The County's LINK GIS mapping has a new Pictometry version of the standard "ortho" or straight down aerial photos displayed for all internal county government users. The 3D photos that Pictometry is known for, also called the "oblique" images, are also available to internal county government users as a tool within the GIS mapping. These images are used by the assessor's staff daily and it improves their ability to locate improvements and classify property. Other departments are also benefiting from this product. | | | |
