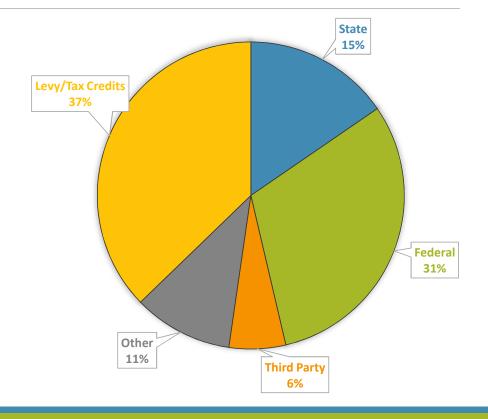

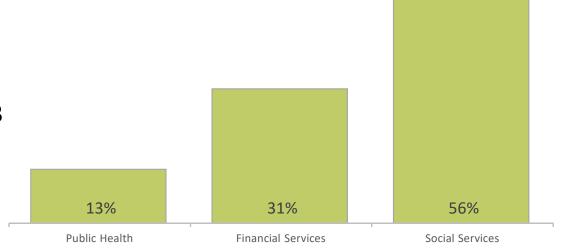

# Why were expenditures lower than expected?

- Out of Home Placements at 90%
  - 54 children in foster care at least one day in 2020
  - Total Foster Care Costs: \$529,627
- Salary/Benefits at 96%
  - Total Salary/Benefits: \$4,575,381
    - Under budget by \$205,345

- Capital Improvements
  - Budgeting items to be used on a future building remodel

# Why were revenues higher than expected?

- Unexpected COVID-19 Funding
  - COVID LPHG (state): \$45,000
  - ESP COVID Homeless Sheltering Grant (state): \$52,856
  - CARES (federal): \$334,000
- Third Party Revenue
  - Adult MH TCM add't: \$27,290
  - Adult MSHO/MSC+ Waiver add't: \$105,510

- Miscellaneous Recoveries
  - Medical Assistance Estate Recovery: \$579,877

#### Fund Balance

- Projected to use \$350,000
- Increased fund balance by \$1,017,414
- •Cash Balance as of 12/31/20: \$5,341,913 (74% in Fund Balance)
