Summary of Issue:		·					
I am respectfully requesting to schedule a residential electronics collection for June 4, 2022 for 10AM to 1PM. I have confirmed this date with Retrofit Companies who have been the contractor for the past 5 collections. They have offered to do the collection event (see attached quote), however costs are anticipated to increase due to fuel costs and labor increase. Pound rate charge increased from .25/lb. last year to .32/lb in 2022. We will be increasing the cost of screened items from \$10.00 to \$15.00 as recommended by Retrofit, and which is line with what neighboring counties are charging. This will help offset vendor increases previously mentioned.  Last year we charged \$10.00 per screen item and recovered 61% of the cost of the collection. The collection cost was \$3310.00 (\$1000.00 is the event fee where they supply two staff, gaylord boxes, pallets, plastic wrapping, and semi/trailer for transportation) and we took in \$2020.00 for revenue. All non-screened items will be free-of-charge. Last year totals from June 5, 2021 were: 119 Households participated and 202 screens were collected.
