• Communication and Branding: Branding project has identified the marketing strategy and tagline:

Naturally Better


The next steps include meeting with stakeholders (City, townships, chambers, etc.) to spread the message and get all on board to speak the same language. A marketing campaign will kick off on May 15.

- River Trails: Economic Development is collaborating with Ripplesippi Trail committee and running a contest to have the community help name our river trail system.
- Northwoods ATV Trail System: promoting the trail system and vision for Axtell area to be the "Valley Fair of the North". Currently building out the Mille Lacs Connector.
- Arts & Entertainment: Continued collaboration with community stakeholders that are creating momentum in our community. A great example is the "Entertainment Alley" in downtown Aitkin.
- Business Development & Recreation Grant: The purpose of this grant fund is to leverage county funds, private funds and volunteer efforts to increase small business development activities in Aitkin County, with an emphasis on increasing sustained tourism and recreation activities. The Aitkin County Board of Commissioners, have approved funding to be used to directly impact the Community of Aitkin County by executing the Aitkin County Business Development & Recreation Grant.



Broadband

- McGrath Project: Construction will begin as soon as the snow melts with a project completion goal of October, 2023. The grant completion deadline is March 31, 2024.
- **Digital Connection Committee:** Minnesota Office of Broadband is requesting our help. Aitkin County is the lead on a team of local community leaders focusing on identifying the specific needs for broadband in our community. This committee work will benefit our unserved and underserved residents.
- **DEED Border to Border Grants:** Mille Lacs Energy, Savage Communications and Paul Bunyan Communications have all applied for the current B2B grant round. All three will be building out fiber in Aitkin County in 2023.





Child Care

- **DEED Economic Development Childcare Grant:** Aitkin County was awarded \$100,000 to be used to increase new childcare facilities in Aitkin County
- 2023 Childcare Acceleration Grant: \$100,000 (DEED Grant) will be awarded to potential new childcare facilities in Aitkin County. Eligible applications can include licensing and training fees, home remodel to meet state requirement standards and equipment and supplies for new childcare providers. We are also developing a scholarship program with Central Lakes College for Aitkin County residents to study early childhood education.







Business Retention, Expansion and Attraction

- Revitalization Grant: The purpose of this grant fund is to help support local businesses to upgrade/revitalize the outside presence of their business property in our community in an effort to drive economic growth. As business owners and members of our community, it is important that we establish and maintain an image of growth and success. The fund will help support upgrades of awnings, signage, outdoor aesthetics and general business image and appearance.
- Business Attraction: We continue to work to attract and this will increase as the marketing program and momentum continues.
