At its July 10, 2023 meeting, the Natural Resources Advisory Committee passed a motion to proceed with the sale. Minnesota Statutes, chapter 282 only allows for the private sale of tax-forfeited land through special legislation. The Land Commissioner has determined that the county's land management interests would best be served if the land was returned to private ownership. Both parcels of tax forfeited land involved in the sale have been classified as non-conservation. Alternatives, Options, Effects on Others/Comments: The county currently does not receive a PILT payment on these parcels because they are platted and within the city limits of Hill City. Recommended Action/Motion: Pass a motion for the Land Commissioner to seek special legislation to allow for the private sale of parcels 57-1-088400 and 57-1-088500 to Phillip Gerber.
