

Restaurant Revitalization Fund

Eligible entities may include “businesses where the public or patrons assemble for the primary purpose of being served food or drink.”

Eligible entities are businesses where the public or patrons assemble for the primary purpose of being served food or drink, including:

Restaurants	Breweries and Microbreweries
Snack and nonalcoholic beverage bars	Brewpubs, Taprooms and Tasting Rooms
Food stands, food trucks, or food carts	Bakeries
Caterers	Wineries and Distilleries
Bars, lounges, saloons, or taverns	Inns

Entities not eligible include:

- Permanently closed business
- State or local government-owned or operated business
- Publicly-traded company or majority owned and controlled by publicly-traded company
- Pending application for or has received Shuttered Venue Operators Grant

Eligible uses of funds from the RRF grant may include:

- Business Payroll Costs, including Paid Sick Leave
- Business Rent / Business Mortgage
- Business Debt Service
- Business Utilities
- Business Food and Beverage Expenses, including Raw Materials
- Business Maintenance Expenses
- Construction of Outdoor Seating
- Business Supplies
- Covered Supplier Costs
- Business Operating Expenses
